Glenn Yanos: The House Rules have been amended by the Executive Committee and Board of Trustees as of April 2. Glenn read the amendments as follows (changes highlighted in yellow):

Article II: Guests

Members are encouraged to bring their family and friends to the club. All visitors of good will are welcomed in a spirit of Gemütlichkeit. All guests, except minor children of members, shall be registered in the guest register in the lobby. Sponsoring members shall sign them in and are responsible for their conduct. Guests, after three (3) visits within the calendar year, must apply for membership to enter the club. The three-visit rule will be waived to guests with applications in process. **Exceptions to this rule may be made on an individual basis with prior approval by the Membership Committee Chair or alternate designee member of the Executive Committee.** Guests or applicants are not permitted to purchase alcoholic beverages. Applications are available at the club and on the club's website.

Article V, Section 3:

No person may consume or have on their person anywhere on Liederkrantz property any alcoholic beverage that has not been supplied by the Liederkrantz. **Exceptions to this rule may be made on an individual basis with prior written approval by the Executive Committee.**
