



**On Tap  
Lancaster Liederkrantz Beer News  
November 21, 2018**

There are some interesting new beers on tap and lots of returning favorites. Check them out!

Ever Grain Brewing, in the 4400 block of Carlisle Pike, Camp Hill, has been open for over 2 years and offers a quality lineup of ales and lagers. Brewer Bruce Tanner had a successful run at Troegs and now has established a great reputation with West Shore beer fans. The extremely popular and well regarded **Ever Grain Joose Juicy IPA** is a great example of the pleasures of a fresh IPA. A Mid-Atlantic take on a New England style IPA, it has a strong malty back bone (6%) supporting 60 IBUs of resinous, piney and citrusy hops.

**Oktoberfest** is still underway at the Liederkrantz bar with **Hofbrau** and **Paulaner** brands of this popular seasonal. The Hofbrau is a delicious lager, and at 6.3% ABV is at the stronger end of this style. The use of Münchner malt (a specialty darker malt) gives it the light Bernstein color. Caramel and biscuit flavors are present along with a zesty hop aroma. The Paulaner version is a lighter take at 5.8%. A full-bodied beer with a rich malt flavor and dark toffee notes, it has an underlying fruitiness and deft hop balance.

Harviestoun has brewed in Scotland of over thirty years, both as part of conglomerates and, as now, an independent. Their styles are all full bodied; good for warding off the chill of a night walk home from the pub. The top rated **Harviestoun Old Engine Oil** is a bitter chocolatey 6% English Porter that tastes like a stronger beer. Very appealing in the glass, this is a cold weather warmer.

Iconic and eclectic Dogfish Head Brewery in Delaware is known for its innovative and unusual lineup. In 2010, Brewery Sam Caligioni designed an imperial stout honoring the 40th anniversary of the release of "Bitches Brew", Miles Davis' 1970 landmark fusion recording. The **Dogfish Head Bitch's Brew** is extremely dark and brewed with three parts imperial stout and one-part Tej; an African mead wine (or honey wine) which is made with gesho root for bittering. At 9% ABV, it's a beer to tickle your jazz soul.

The featured brewery at the moment appears to be **Weihenstephan** with **Braupackt**, **Pils**, **Original**, and **Hefe** available at this time. The Liederkrantz is proud to serve their beers; the oldest and, according to many, still the leader in Bavarian brewing.
