


4. Once you have created an account, you are ready to bid, but first be sure to review auction details!

## Online-Only Bidding Information

- Bidding that takes place on HiBid takes the form of both absentee bidding and live "e-Bay style" bidding.
  - Absentee Bidding-- Prior to the close of the auction (which typically starts at 7pm on the day the sale ends), bids can be left that will be executed by the computer automatically in case you cannot watch the actual close of the auction. To do this, simply click, for example, bid \$10.00 (as seen below). The computer will then prompt you to leave a max bid for the item and ask you to confirm your bid. And that is all you must do; the auction software will then bid on your behalf up to that amount.



- **eBay- style Bidding—** At 7pm, the last day of the auction, the lots will begin to close, one lot at a time with 10 seconds between each lot. During this time, you may watch the auction and place bids as it closes. If you are outbid, you can continue to leave bids as desired. A one- minute extension is placed on the close of the lot, if there is still active bidding. Once the time runs up and no one has bid, the lot will close.
- Other online bidding tips:
  - If you do not have access to a computer, ask one of the ladies in the office to help you leave an absentee bid.
  - Please be aware of pick up dates. We cannot hold items past the stated pickup dates, and they will be forfeit if not picked up.
  - Payment will take place automatically the day following the sale using the credit card that was used to register for the auction.
