

Proposal #D:	-Remove a statement that is in the Constitution under Trustees and place it in the By-Laws under Article V Operation and Conduct -Move the statement about fiscal year to the new Financial Affairs article. -Add a statement about providing needed records to the Financial Secretary & Treasurer.
Current:	
<p>Constitution – Article IX Board of Trustees The two committees may draft a code of rules necessary for keeping order. The rules may be posted in the club, and any member of either committee shall have the power to enforce the same.</p> <p>By-Laws – ARTICLE V Operation and Conduct Sec. 1 The fiscal year of the Society will commence June 1 and end May 31</p> <p>Sec. 2 There shall be no political affiliation or endorsement.</p>	
Proposed:	
<p>ARTICLE V Operation and Conduct</p> <p>Sec. 1 The Executive Committee and the Board of Trustees shall draft a code of rules necessary for keeping order. These rules, known as the House Rules, shall be posted in the club, and any member of either committee shall have the power to enforce the same.</p> <p>Sec. 2 The value of inventory of beer, liquor, food, small games of chance and records from associated accounts shall be provided by the responsible parties to the Financial Secretary and the Treasurer within 30 days after the end of each fiscal year.</p> <p>Sec. 3 There shall be no political affiliation or endorsement.</p>	
Rationale:	-The statement about the House Rules was under Trustees, but referred to “the two committees;” this revision provides clarity. -Financial Secretary and Treasurer need the information listed in Sec. 2 in order to file governmental reports which are required by law.
